They were informed that this Museum was founded by Asiatic Society of Bengal in Kolkata, in India 1814 and then it was called Imperial Museum at Kolkata in British India era. They were wondered to see rare collections of antiques, armories and ornaments, fossils, skeletons, mummies and Mughal paintings.
